Run 2 the Cross 5K has raised \$261,300 since 2010. Below is a list of the theme from each year, the amount we raised and the things we funded.

2019 - “Care About Others as Much as You Care About Yourself” \$46,000

- Provided funds to fight the Human Trafficking Epidemic
- Built our 11th well near the Jamba secondary school
- Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 4 individuals to rehab
- Provided funds for two counselors who serve at the Emmaus House in Cap-Hatien Haiti.
- Helped 5 local individuals get medical help, pay utilities, and help with adoptions.
- Supported Isaiah’s Call – Providing food for families through a backpack program.
- Supported Room in the Inn Shoals/Room at the Table – Homeless and Hunger Programs
- Supported Common Ground Ministries – A inner-city mentoring and ministry program for at-risk boys.
- Supported Partners 4 Africa, World Race, Night of Harmony, and Mercy House.
- Supported 3 children who live in Africa and Haiti.

2018 – “Our Hands are God’s Hands” \$41,000

- Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 12 men/women to rehab
- Built our 10th well
- Sponsored 4 orphan children in Haiti and Zimbabwe for the year.
- Helped fund a relief effort to get 5 women who were victims of sex trafficking and exploitation the help they needed.
- Funded 5 micro loans via World Vision for women.
- Paid for medicine and medical expenses for families in the Shoals and in Africa
- Supported Isaiah’s Call, Room in the Inn Shoals, Be Still Ministries, Common Ground Ministries
- Provided a water tank in the South Pacific
- Helped with Cyclone Disaster Relief in Africa
- Helped 3 at-risk boys attend football camp

2017 – “We love God because God loved us first” \$33,000

- Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 13 to rehab
- Built our 9th well
- Funded counseling for young men and women at the Emmaus House in Cap-Hatien Haiti.
- Sponsored Christmas and bedding for the Emmaus House.
- Sponsored 3 orphan children in Haiti and Zimbabwe for the year.
- Paid for housing for an at-risk woman.
- Funded 5 micro loans via World Vision for women.
- Supplied \$800 worth of medicine for children in need
- Supported Isaiah’s Call and Room in the Inn Shoals
- Helped fund a relief effort to get 5 women who were victims of sex trafficking and exploitation the help they needed.

2016 – “Helping Hands” - \$38,000

- Funded the digging of our 8th well
- Sent 10 people to rehab
- Funded counseling for men & women at the Emmaus House
- Sponsored two orphan children in Zimbabwe for the year.
- Paid for 2 tanks for clean water in Haiti by partnering with UNA.
- Supported Isaiah’s Call and Room in the Inn Shoals and the Race for a Reason
- Funded building cisterns at the Christian School in Tanzania
- Helped fund a relief effort to get 5 women who were victims of sex trafficking and exploitation the help they needed.
- Supported a missionary in Africa - Hailey Mlangeni and his family
- Sent money to help flood victims in Baton Rouge, LA

2015 – “#send me” - \$32,000

- Sent 5 people to rehab
- Funded the digging of 1 more fresh Water Wells in Africa
- Helped the Homeless - Room in the Inn Shoals and feed hungry children through Isaiah’s Call
- Sponsored two orphan children in Zimbabwe for the year

2014 – “Love God, Love Others” - \$22,000

- Sent 3 people to rehab
- Funded the digging of 1 more fresh Water Wells in Africa
- Funded 7 Micro Loans for Women in 3rd World Countries
- Helped the homeless in the Shoals

2013- “Love Does” - \$21,000

- Began the Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 3 people to rehab
- Funded the digging of 2 more fresh Water Wells in Africa
- Funded 8 Micro Loans for Women in 3rd World Countries
- Fed the hungry in the Shoals by funding some local food pantries

2012- “All Who Are Thirsty” - \$12,000

- Funded the digging of 2 fresh Water Wells in Africa
- Provided funding for 2 people to go to addiction recovery rehab.

2011 – “A Cup of Cool Water” - \$10,000

- Funding the digging of fresh water well in Zimbabwe, Africa.
- Helped fund local food pantries.
- Helped financially support one person to go to rehab.

2010 – “Run with Perseverance” - \$6,000

- Provided local children in need with toys for Christmas.
