Run 2 The Cross began out of a prayer that God would turn a tragedy into something much bigger than anything we could have ever imagined. When you don't know where your story is going, God does. Your support of the Run has allowed God to spread his love and care all around the world.

Here's what the Run has done!!

2021 - "Don't forget to do good and share what God has given us" -\$72,000

Funded the building of our 13th well - a Super Well at Amazon Christian Academy, which included the well, 13 solar panels, batteries, tanks, booster pump and pipes

Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 5 people to rehab

Funded a rain water tank for a remote village in Fiji

Supported two counselors who serve at the Emmaus House in Cap-Hatien Haiti.

Supported 4 children with basic needs and school supplies (2 in Haiti, 2 in Zimbabwe).

Supported Multiple Organizations: One Place of the Shoals, Room in the Inn Shoals, Ilsaiah's Call, Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, United Cerebral Palsy Foundation, Safeplace, Shoals Save A Life, Partners 4 Africa, Renewed Spirit Counseling, Room in the Inn Shoals, and Isaiah's Call

Supplied curtains for a new house in Haiti

Supported various ministries at Crosspoint Church

Supported illimiNations - a collective impact alliance of Bible translation partners and resource partners working together to eradicate Bible poverty in this generation

2020 - "God Lives in Us" \$93,105

Funded the digging of our 12th well near the Chaanga Primary School in Eastern Zam

Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 7 people to rehab

Supported 4 children with basic needs and school supplies (2 in Haiti, 2 in Zimbabwe).

Helped 6 girls escape from sexual trafficking and exploitation.

Helped with moving and funeral expenses for several families.

Supported two counselors who serve at the Emmaus House in Cap-Hatien Haiti.

Provided medicine, school supplies and help with the costs of cancer treatments for 2 families.

Supported Isaiah's Call and Room in the Inn Shoals, and Common Ground Ministries and the Mission of Mercy

Supported One Place of the Shoals; provided funds for advanced certification training and a computer program for the forensic unit investigators to help them track predators.

2019 - "Care About Others as Much as You Care About Yourself" \$46,00

Funded the digging of our 11th well

Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 4 people to rehab

Provided funds to fight the Human Trafficking Epidemic

Provided funds for two counselors who serve at the Emmaus House in Cap-Hatien Haiti.

Helped 5 local individuals get medical help, pay utilities, and help with adoptions.

Supported Isaiah's Call and Room in the Inn Shoals and Common Ground Ministries

Supported Partners 4 Africa, World Race, Night of Harmony, and Mercy House.

Supported 3 children who live in Africa and Haiti.

2018 – "Our Hands are God's Hands" \$41,000

Funded the digging of our 10th well

Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 12 people to rehab

Sponsored 4 orphan children in Haiti and Zimbabwe for the year.

Helped fund a relief effort for 5 women who were victims of sex trafficking and exploitation.
Funded 5 micro loans via World Vision for women.
Paid for medicine and medical expenses for families in the Shoals and in Africa
Supported Isaiah's Call, Room in the Inn Shoals, Be Still Ministries, Common Ground Ministries
Provided a water tank in the South Pacific
Helped with Cyclone Disaster Relief in Africa
Helped 3 at-risk boys attend football camp

2017 – “We love God because God loved us first” \$33,000

Funded the digging of our 9th well
Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 13 people to rehab
Funded counseling for young men and women at the Emmaus House in Cap-Hatien Haiti.
Sponsored Christmas and bedding for the Emmaus House.
Sponsored 3 orphan children in Haiti and Zimbabwe for the year.
Paid for housing for an at-risk woman.
Funded 5 micro loans via World Vision for women.
Supplied \$800 worth of medicine for children in need
Supported Room in the Inn Shoals and Isaiah's Call
Helped fund a relief effort for 5 women who were victims of sex trafficking and exploitation

2016 – “Helping Hands” - \$38,000

Funded the digging of our 8th well
Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 10 people to rehab
Funded counseling for men & women at the Emmaus House
Sponsored two orphan children in Zimbabwe for the year.
Paid for 2 tanks for clean water in Haiti by partnering with UNA.
Supported Isaiah's Call, Room in the Inn Shoals and the Race for a Reason
Funded building cisterns at the Christian School in Tanzania
Helped fund a relief effort for 5 women who were victims of sex trafficking and exploitation.
Supported a missionary in Africa - Hailey Mlangeni and his family
Sent money to help flood victims in Baton Rouge, LA

2015 – “#send me” - \$32,000

Funded the digging of our 7th fresh water well
Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 3 people to rehab
Supported Room in the Inn Shoals and Isaiah's Call
Sponsored two orphan children in Zimbabwe for the year

2014 – “Love God, Love Others” - \$22,000

Funded the digging of 6th fresh water well
Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 3 people to rehab
Funded 7 Micro-Loans for Women in 3rd World Countries
Supported Room in the Inn Shoals

2013- “Love Does” - \$21,000

Funded the digging of our 4th and 5th fresh water well
Began the Addiction Recovery Scholarship Program – sent 3 people to rehab
Funded 8 Micro-Loans for Women in 3rd World Countries
Fed the hungry in the Shoals by funding some local food pantries

2012- “All Who Are Thirsty” - \$12,000

Funded the digging of our 2nd and 3rd fresh water well
Provided funding for 2 people to go to addiction recovery rehab

2011 – “A Cup of Cool Water” - \$10,000

Funding the digging of our first fresh water well in Zimbabwe, Africa.
Helped fund local food pantries.
Helped financially support one person to go to rehab.

2010 – “Run with Perseverance” - \$6,000

Provided local children in need with toys for Christmas
